## Dubois/Brown/McCalla Timber Sale Notice

Bid Opening: Friday August 29, 2014 at 10:00 AM CDT

\*\*The following bid invitation is for 3 separate tracts of timber that are adjacent to each other. A bid will be required for each tract. The cumulative high bid will be accepted for all three tracts. Successful bidder will either buy all three of the tracts or none. Please place a separate bid for each tract!

Attn: Buyers of Standing Timber,

Tim Dubois, Lisa Brown, and Harold McCalla have authorized Arbor Springs Forestry to serve as their agent in the sale of said hardwood timber located on their property near White Bluff in Dickson County, TN. The properties are identified as <u>Control Map 077 Parcel 016.03 (Dubois)</u>, <u>Control Map 077 Parcel 016.05 (Brown)</u>, and Control Map 077 Parcel 035.12 (McCalla).

#### General Description of Sale:

This is a marked sale of quality hardwood sawtimber and pulpwood on three separate tracts (*see sale map*).

<u>Dubois Timber:</u> The sale unit includes +/- 22.43 acres of "<u>BLUE marked</u>" timber which contains 75,850 bdft of hardwood sawtimber and 480 tons of hardwood pulp/topwood. All hardwood sawtimber trees average 154 bdft/tree. There are <u>23 White oak</u> trees with an estimated <u>2,411 bdft</u> of potential Veneer and <u>53 White oak</u> trees with an estimated <u>6,119 bdft</u> of potential <u>Stave.</u> The estimated Veneer/Stave is pulled out of the total volumes for each species. Potential veneer trees are marked with a "V". White oak makes up 46% of the total volume, followed by Red oak (22 %), and Yellow poplar (14%).

Brown Timber: The sale unit includes +/- 22.28 acres of "TEAL marked" timber which contains 94,614 bdft of hardwood sawtimber and 520 tons of hardwood pulp/topwood. All hardwood sawtimber trees average 175 bdft/tree. There are 32 White oak trees with an estimated 3,595 bdft of potential Veneer and 68 White oak trees with an estimated 6,339 bdft of potential Stave. The estimated Veneer/Stave is pulled out of the total volumes for each species. Potential veneer trees are marked with a "V". White oak makes up 36% of the total volume, followed by Yellow poplar (24 %), and Red oak (21%).

<u>McCalla Timber:</u> The sale unit includes +/- 5.61 acres of "<u>PINK marked</u>" timber which contains 15,029 bdft of hardwood sawtimber and 30 tons of hardwood pulp/topwood. All hardwood sawtimber trees average 169 bdft/tree. There are <u>7 White oak</u> trees with an estimated <u>824 bdft</u> of potential <u>Stave.</u> The

estimated Stave is pulled out of the total volumes for each species. White oak makes up 37% of the total volume, followed by Yellow poplar (20 %), and Red oak (19%).

The tract can be accessed directly from Fowler Rd. There will be 1 decking area for all three tracts. The proposed decking area is shown on the sale map and flagged with "PINK" flagging at the site. There are existing skid trails that can be used to remove timber. The tract has excellent access and would serve as a good winter time operation. BMP's must be applied throughout the sale including removal of tops from SMZ's.

### Location:

The tract is located just south of Fowler Rd. near White Bluff, TN. <u>Access from White Bluff:</u> From HWY 70/HWY 47 Intersection travel approximately 2.3 miles. Turn right onto HWY 250 and travel approximately 0.7 miles. Turn left onto Petty Rd. and travel 0.3 miles. Take a slight right onto Fowler road and travel approximately 1 mile. The timber marked timber will be located on your left. There are pink flags hung at the proposed logging deck. The skid trail can be traveled by smaller 4x4 truck or ATV. This is a good place to park to view timber.

### Sale Description:

The sale units are shown on the attached map. (Dubois Timber highlighted in Light Blue), (Brown timber highlighted in Yellow), and (McCalla timber highlighted in Pink).

<u>Dubois Timber:</u> There are +/- 22.43 acres of marked timber. Within the sale unit only those trees marked with <u>BLUE PAINT</u> at dbh and below stump level are eligible for harvest. All sawtimber trees are marked with a horizontal "SLASH", pulpwood trees are marked with a "DOT", and trees marked with a "SLASH/DOT" represent a deduction is volume estimate. Potential Veneer trees are marked with a "V". Property lines are well marked with <u>ORANGE FLAGGING & OLD FENCES</u>. The location of all roads, skid trails, and logging decks must be approved in advance by the owner or agent. SMZ's are not flagged on the ground, but shown on the map. BMP's must be applied throughout the sale.

Brown Timber: There are +/- 22.28 acres of marked timber. Within the sale unit only those trees marked with <u>TEAL PAINT</u> at dbh and below stump level are eligible for harvest. All sawtimber trees are marked with a horizontal "SLASH", pulpwood trees are marked with a "DOT", and trees marked with a "SLASH/DOT" represent a deduction is volume estimate. Potential Veneer trees are marked with a "V". Property lines are well marked with <u>PINK FLAGGING</u>. The location of all roads, skid trails, and logging decks must be approved in advance by the owner or agent. SMZ's are not flagged on the ground, but shown on the map. BMP's must be applied throughout the sale.

McCalla Timber: There are +/- 5.61 acres of marked timber. Within the sale unit only those trees marked with <u>PINK PAINT</u> at dbh and below stump level are eligible for harvest. All sawtimber trees are marked with a horizontal "SLASH", pulpwood trees are marked with a "DOT", and trees marked with a "SLASH/DOT" represent a deduction is volume estimate. Property lines are well marked with <u>PINK FLAGGING & OLD FENCES</u>. The location of all roads, skid trails, and logging decks must be approved in advance by the owner or agent. SMZ's are not flagged on the ground, but shown on the map. BMP's must be applied throughout the sale.

Bidders are welcome to look at the timber at your convenience. I would also be happy to meet with you on an appointment basis to show you the timber.

#### Terms of Sale:

BID OPENING: Sealed bids on a submitted lump sum basis only will be accepted until 10:00 AM CDT on Friday August 1, 2014 at which time they will be opened. The bid opening will be held at Donna's Place located in Burns, TN (Across from Dollar General on HWY 96) Buyers are welcome to attend the bid opening and join us for breakfast. Bids may also be submitted by mail, fax, or email on the attached or similar Bid Offer Form, but must be received no later than 8:00 AM on August 29, 2014. (Morning of the bid). Please call if sending a fax to ensure it was received.

PREFORMANCE BOND: The Successful Bidder shall furnish the Seller's Agent with a Performance Bond in the form of a check in the amount of \$3,500.00. This will be due at contract signing.

PAYMENT: 100% of payment for said timber is due at contract signing by September 19, 2014.

- The attached volumes are estimates and for informational purposes only. The Seller and Seller's Agent (Arbor Springs Forestry) makes no guarantees to the quantity and quality of marked timber. Bidders should satisfy themselves as to the quality and quantity of the said timber.
- There are 206 individual pulp sized trees marked and 16 cull trees that must be felled or adequately girdled on the Dubois Tract.
- There are 124 individual pulp sized trees marked and 15 cull trees that must be felled or adequately girdled on the Brown Tract.
- Proposed log deck is marked on the attached map and flagged with pink flagging on the ground. No decks are allowed past the house on Lisa Browns property. Timber from all 3 tracts will be decked on the Dubois tract.



#### TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF SALE

- 1. The Purchaser agrees to make payment to the Seller at contract signing.
- 2. The Purchaser shall furnish the Seller's Agent with a Performance Bond in the form of a check in the amount of \$3,500.00. This Bond will apply for all 3 tracts
- 3. This Agreement shall be in full force and effect for a period of <u>1.5 years (18 months)</u> from contract signing date. Should restoration work or timber removal not be completed prior to contract expiration due to inclement weather conditions, the Purchaser shall be granted an additional period for such restoration equal to the time of the suspension.
- 4. The Seller guarantees title to said timber and agrees to defend it against any and all claims whatsoever.
- 5. Notice of the intention of the Purchaser to begin removal of said timber shall be given to the Seller and the Seller's Agent, Arbor Springs Forestry, 333 Beechwood Drive, Burns, TN 37029, Phone: (615) 498-8700, at least 48 hours before any logging activity begins. A "PreHarvest" meeting will take place on premises before any said timber is removed.
- 6. Upon completion of all logging operations or as soon thereafter as conditions permit, the Purchaser shall smooth ruts, created by the Purchaser, out of all existing and newly created skid and truck roads, and the log landing(s) must be cleared of all debris related to the logging operation, smoothed and seeded. The purchaser agrees to install water diversion in accordance with Tennessee "Best Management Practices" suggestions to prevent erosion and water quality issues. Details about restoration will be outlined in Timber Sale Contract.
- 7. The Seller agrees to allow the Purchaser, his agents or employees, to enter upon said premises, for the purpose of removing the designated timber there from, and do such other things as may be necessary in connection with the operation, including the right and privilege of the Purchaser to use sufficient and necessary space in and upon said premises to handle, load, and haul all timber covered by this Agreement, and no other.
- 8. Only trees under the terms of this Agreement shall be cut. Trees not designated for sale under this agreement shall be protected against unnecessary injury. No cut, broken, or uprooted trees shall be left hanging in standing trees. All trees cut shall be felled onto the premises of the Seller; any tree felled over the property line of the premises shall be brought back onto the premises immediately, and any damage that such activity creates shall also be repaired immediately.
- 9. Within the sale units all Marked trees must be felled and merchantable products be removed at the option of the buyer.
- 10. The Purchaser shall remove all materials brought onto the premises prior to the expiration of the term of this Agreement and shall remove on a daily basis any papers, bottles, cans, and materials which may cause an unsafe, unsanitary or unsightly conditions.
- 11. Before entry onto the premises to conduct operations under this Agreement, the Purchaser shall provide the Seller's Agent with Certificates of Insurance showing general liability insurance with a single limit of liability no less than One Million Dollars (1,000,000.00) and Worker's Compensation Insurance as required by law. The Purchaser shall not conduct any further operations during the term of this Agreement upon the premises after the expiration of insurance as shown by the certificate provided to the Seller's Agent until the Purchaser provides the Seller's Agent with such additional certificates evidencing the renewal or replacement of such insurance to fulfill the requirement of this paragraph.
- 12. This Agreement shall not be assigned by the Purchaser without the written consent of the Seller. Purchaser shall have the right to use contract loggers for harvest operations.
- 13. The Purchaser shall indemnify and save the Seller and the Seller's Agent harmless from and against any and all claims for damages to property, or injury to, death of, any person, including employees of the Purchaser, of any action arising out of the actions of the Purchaser.
